

JESUS IS TRANSFIGURED ON THE MOUNTAIN

Mark 9

9 And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power. (Spiritually speaking-He was going to give them a vision.) (The Bible tells us “²⁸ Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom.” Matthew 16:28) (The Bible tells us “³⁰ And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.” Matthew 24:30) (The Bible tells us “³⁰ And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.” Luke 9:27) (The Bible tells us “²² Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.” Luke 22:1)

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² And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them. (Had a purpose for taking three-don't know for sure why.) (The Bible tells us “¹⁷ And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain (A vision, a high hill-not very mountainous; symbolic of the Kingdom of God.) apart (Showing them the future for all mankind), ² And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light (We will be like Jesus; transformation of everything-even clothing.). ³ And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias (Elijah) talking with him. ⁴ Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias (Elijah). ⁵ While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased (means to obey); hear ye him. ⁶ And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid. ⁷ And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid. ⁸ And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only. ⁹ And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead. ¹⁰ And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come (The Bible tells us (In contrast to those in vs. 13-15) “¹⁶ Then they that feared (Those that fear the Lord, the rement.) the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened,

and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. ¹⁷ And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. ¹⁸ Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.”

¹¹ And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias (Elijah) must come first come? ¹¹ And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things. ¹² But I say unto you, That Elias (Elijah) is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. ¹³ Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist (Herod killed John the Baptist.). Matthew 17:1-13) (The Bible tells us “²⁸ And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray. ²⁹ And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance (face) was altered, and his raiment was white and glistening (Was a vision; they saw not the reality. In a vision anything can happen.) ³⁰ And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias (Elijah): ³¹ Who appeared in glory, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem. ³² But Peter and they that were with him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw his glory, and the two men that stood with him. ³³ And it came to pass, as they departed from him, Peter said unto Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias: not knowing what he said. ³⁴ While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud. ³⁵ And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him. ³⁶ And when the voice was past, Jesus was found alone. And they kept it close, and told no man in those days any of those things which they had seen.” Luke 9:28-36)

³ And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller (His brilliance of the light.) on earth can white them.

⁴ And there appeared unto them Elias (Elijah) with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.

⁵ And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias (Elijah).

⁶ For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid.

⁷ And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him (God said this.). (The Bible tells us “³⁴ Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the

LORD filled the tabernacle.” Exodus 40:34) (The Bible tells us “¹⁷ For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” ¹⁸ And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.” 2 Peter 1:17-18) (The Bible tells us “² Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;” Hebrews 1:2) (The Bible tells us “³ How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;” Hebrews 2:3) (The Bible tells us “²⁵ See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven:” Hebrews 12:25)

⁸ And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves.

⁹ And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.

¹⁰ And they kept that saying with themselves, questioning one with another what the rising from the dead should mean. (The Bible tells us “⁵ Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:” Malachi 4:5) (The Bible tells us “¹⁴ And if ye will receive it, this is Elias (Elijah), which was for to come.” Matthew 11:14)

¹¹ And they asked him, saying, Why say the scribes that Elias must first come?

¹² And he answered and told them, Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things; and how it is written of the Son of man, that he must suffer many things, and be set at nought. (12-13) (The Bible tells us “⁵ For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.” Genesis 3:5) (The Bible tells us “⁶ But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. ⁷ All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, ⁸ He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.” Psalms 22:6-8) (The Bible tells us “⁶ I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting. ⁷ For the Lord GOD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed.” Isaiah 50:6-7) (The Bible tells us “² For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. ³ He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from

him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.” Isaiah 53:2-3) (The Bible tells us “²⁶ And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.” Daniel 9:26) (The Bible tells us “¹³ For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. ¹⁴ And if ye will receive it, this is Elias (Elijah), which was for to come.” Matthew 11:13-14) (The Bible tells us “¹⁷ And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias (Elijah), to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.” Luke 1:17) (The Bible tells us “¹¹ And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked him, and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.” Luke 13:11) (The Bible tells us “¹⁴ And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:” John 3:14)

¹³ But I say unto you, That Elias (Elijah) is indeed come, and they have done unto him whatsoever they listed, as it is written of him.

JESUS HEALS A DEMON-POSSESSED BOY

¹⁴ And when he came to his disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them. (The Bible tells us “¹⁴ And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying, (He recognized He was the Son of God.) ¹⁵ Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water. ¹⁶ And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him. ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you (A reality among His disciples; of a lack of faith.)? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me. ¹⁸ And Jesus rebuked the devil (demon); and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour (How does a demon get into a child; when they are not properly raised.). ¹⁹ Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? ²⁰ And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. ²¹ Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.” Matthew 17:14-21)

¹⁵ And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to him saluted him.

¹⁶ And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?¹⁷ And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit; (He wasn't there; He was in the mountain.)

¹⁸ And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not. (Self-destructive spirit.)

¹⁹ He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me. (The Bible tells us “⁸ (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)” John 4:8)

²⁰ And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming. (The Bible tells us “²⁶ And when the unclean spirit had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him.” Mark 1:26)

²¹ And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child.

²² And oftentimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

²³ Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. (The Bible tells us “²² And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.” Mark 11:22-24) (The Bible tells us “⁶ And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you (How to increase faith.)” Luke 17:6) (The Bible tells us “⁴⁰ Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God (But there was no faith-what about us in trial-God is there-full power and glory-when we obey God we can be confident He hears.)?” John 11:40) (The Bible tells us “⁹ The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed, ¹⁰ Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.” Acts 14:9 -10)

²⁴ And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief. (The Bible tells us “⁸ For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:” Ephesians 2:8)

²⁵ When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. (The Bible tells us “³⁸ How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing

good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil (Demon); for God was with him.” Acts 10:38)

²⁶ And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.

²⁷ But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.

²⁸ And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

²⁹ And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting. (Powerful challenge, drew closer to God.)

JESUS PREDICTS HIS DEATH THE SECOND TIME

³⁰ And they departed thence, and passed through Galilee; and he would not that any man should know it. (The Bible tells us “²² And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men: ²³ And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again. And they were exceeding sorry.” Matthew 17:22-23) (The Bible tells us “⁴³ And they were all amazed at the mighty power of God. But while they wondered every one at all things which Jesus did, he said unto his disciples, ⁴⁴ Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered (betrayed) into the hands of men. ⁴⁵ But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying (The up to the Last Supper; they didn’t know.)” Luke 9:43-45)

³¹ For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him; and after that he is killed, he shall rise the third day.

³² But they understood not that saying, and were afraid to ask him.

THE DISCIPLES ARGUE ABOUT WHO WOULD BE THE GREATEST

³³ And he came to Capernaum: and being in the house he asked them, What was it that ye disputed among yourselves by the way? (The Bible tells us “¹⁷ And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, ² And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. ³ And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias (Elijah) talking with him. ⁴ Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias (Elijah). ⁵ While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and

behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him (Obey in me; believe in God.). ⁶ And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid. ⁷ And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid. ⁸ And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only. ⁹ And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead. ¹⁰ And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias (Elijah) must first come? ¹¹ And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things (Speaking of the Spirit of Elijah; not a real person.). Matthew 17:1-11) (The Bible tells us ⁴³ And they were all amazed at the mighty power of God. But while they wondered every one at all things which Jesus did, he said unto his disciples, ⁴⁴ Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men. ⁴⁵ But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying.” Luke 9:43-45)

³⁴ But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among themselves, who should be the greatest. (Thoughts of power, self exhaltation.)

³⁵ And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, If any man desire to be first, the same shall be last of all, and servant of all.

³⁶ And he took a child, and set him in the midst of them: and when he had taken him in his arms, he said unto them, (Loving affection like David cared for his flock.)

³⁷ Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me. (The Bible tells us ⁴⁰ He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.” Matthew 10:40) (The Bible tells us ¹⁶ And he took them up in his arms, put his hands upon them, and blessed them.” Mark 10:16) (The Bible tells us ²⁰ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.” John 13:20)

THE DISCIPLES FORBID TO USE JESUS' NAME

³⁸ And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us. (The Bible tells us ²⁶ But there remained two of the men in the camp, the name of the one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the spirit rested upon them; and they were of them that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and they prophesied in the camp. ²⁷ And there ran a young man, and told Moses, and said, Eldad and Medad do prophesy in the camp. ²⁸ And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of

Moses, one of his young men, answered and said, My lord Moses, forbid them. ²⁹ And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his spirit upon them! (The Bible tells us “²⁶ But there remained two of the men in the camp, the name of the one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the spirit rested upon them; and they were of them that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and they prophesied in the camp. ²⁷ And there ran a young man, and told Moses, and said, Eldad and Medad do prophesy in the camp. ²⁸ And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of Moses, one of his young men, answered and said, My lord Moses, forbid them. ²⁹ And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his spirit upon them!” Numbers 11: 26-29)

³⁹ But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me (Soon after speak evil of Me; Whomever He chooses He will do His work through.). (The Bible tells us “ Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost (Spirit)” I Corinthians 12:3

⁴⁰ For he that is not against us is on our part. (The Bible tells us “³⁰ He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.” Matthew 12:30)

⁴¹ For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reward. (The Bible tells us “⁴² And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward.” Matthew 10:42) (The Bible tells us “¹⁷ Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences (When you break the law of God.): but woe unto him, through whom they come! ² It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones. ³ Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him (Don't take vengeance; don't bear a grudge-go to Him on a personal basis.).” Luke 17:1-3)

JESUS WARNS AGAINST TEMPTATION

⁴³ And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: (The Bible tells us “⁶ If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods (someone you trust), which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers;

⁷ Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you, nigh unto thee, or far off from thee, from the one end of the earth even unto the other end of the earth; ⁸ Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him: ⁹ But thou shalt surely kill him; thine hand shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people. ¹⁰ And thou shalt stone him with stones, that he die; because he hath sought to thrust thee away from the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.” Deuteronomy 13:6 -10) (The Bible tells us “²⁹ And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell. ³⁰ And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.” Matthew 5:29 – 30)

⁴⁴ Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched (Gehenna fire; garbage pile.).

⁴⁵ And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: (Idioms for our thinking; actions and deeds.)

⁴⁶ Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

⁴⁷ And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:

⁴⁸ Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. (The Bible tells us “²⁴ And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh (Valley of gehenna; a place in Jerusalem where they this garbage and criminals.” Isaiah 66:24) (The Bible tells us “⁹ Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;” 2 Thessalonians 1:9)

⁴⁹ For every one shall be salted with fire, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt. (The Bible tells us “¹³ And every oblation of thy meat offering shalt thou season with salt; neither shalt thou suffer the salt of the covenant of thy God to be lacking from thy meat offering: with all thine offerings thou shalt offer salt.” Leviticus 2:13) (The Bible tells us “²⁴ And thou shalt offer them before the LORD, and the priests shall cast salt upon them, and they shall offer them up for a burnt offering unto the LORD.” Ezekiel 43:24)

⁵⁰ Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another. (The Bible tells us “¹³ Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.” Matthew 5:13) (The Bible tells us “³⁴ Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned?” Luke 14:34)

BUT WHILE THEY WONDERED EVERY ONE AT ALL EVERY ONE AT ALL THINGS WHICH JESUS DID, HE SAID UNTO HIS DISCIPLES, LET THESE SAYINGS SINK DOWN INTO YOUR EARS: FOR THE SON OF MAN DELIVERED (BETRAYED) INTO THE HANDS OF MEN. BUT THEY UNDERSTOOD NOT THIS SAYING, AND IT WAS HID FROM THEM, THAT THEY PERCEIVED IT NOT; AND THEY FEAR TO ASK HIM OF THAT SAYING (Up to the last supper; they didn't know.)
